

SHADOW WATER POLO: 2024/2025 (updated August 17, 2024)

The following details are particularly important.

Please review them in detail and ensure that your child is familiar with these guidelines.

TPASC Entrances

There are two entrances - one on the north end of the building and one to the East

Arrival time

- Arrive <u>15 minutes</u> before training time (e.g., if your practice starts at 7pm, then arrive at 645pm)
- Children wear their bathing suit under the appropriate clothing
- In the winter boots/shoes are taken off at the doors BEFORE entering the pool area this is very important

Entering the pools

- When you enter the doors from the North side of TPASC (coming in from the North parking lot), proceed down the main hallway; their are turnstiles on your right just past the indoor track
 - If you are trying us out, check-in at Guest Services (the desk just beyond the turnstiles) to ask to be let in by giving them your name indicating you are with Shadow Water Polo
 - After you try us out and become a member, the child MUST get a TPASC card (contact us at shadowwaterpoloclub@gmail.com) to enter into the pool area; lost TPASC cards are replaced for a fee so please keep it safe

•

- After entering the turnstiles, go downstairs, turn left and go through the first set of doors on your right (there are the change rooms)
- The **Dive Tank** is on the north end of the building (past the lane swimming) and the **Training Pool** is on the south end of the building (check your child's schedule to advise them on where to go)
- When it is raining/snowing, please make sure that your athlete takes his/her shoes off before entering the pool deck; this is especially important
- Parents can watch children from the spectator stands

Here is a TPASC floor map.

Level 1:

- This is the "basement" level where the pools are found.
- The Training Pool is on the left side of the building. The Dive Tank shows a diver in the pool on the pool to the furthest right of the building.
- You enter on Level 2 and have to take stairs down to Level 1.

Level 2:

- The red arrows on Level 2 indicate the entrances (the one on the right is the entrance from the North Parking lot).
- The Service Desk for gathering your TPASC card and gaining entrance to the turnstiles is the "?" area (found on left side of picture).



• The spectator areas are accessed by this level.

Change rooms are available.

What to bring?

- Water bottle
- Towel
- Clothes to change into after swimming
- Some children bring flip flops for the change room
- Swim googles are optional; water polo is not played with swim goggles but they may be used when children are swimming lengths
